



STANDARDS AND AWARDS

Check-in for Artists: Sunday, October 2, 2011 from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM. Please check in only for your own square. Any square not in progress by 10:15 AM will be reassigned.

We will review all squares during the day and again before awarding prizes. To be considered for a cash prize, including People's Choice, and to be considered for a gift certificate to a local venue for the Environmental Theme, work must meet the Festival Standards listed below.

This year, the Rotary Club of Providence commemorates Rotary International's Theme for 2011-2012 - Reach Within to Embrace Humanity; The Rotary Club of Providence's 100th Anniversary, and Providence's 375th Anniversary Celebration.

- **Reproduction of copyrighted material is prohibited**
- Work must be designed and created by the Team working on the square
- Artwork must remain within the boundaries of the square, and the square number must remain clear and unchanged
- Chalk must be applied in dry form; other media are not permitted
- Glitter and other decorative sprays are not allowed
- Hairspray or water may be used to fix drawing; no other fixatives are permitted
- All work must be suitable for family viewing
- Corporate names or logos may not appear in the work
- Work that is derogatory or conveys violence is not allowed

We will provide you with a palette of 48 colors of pastel chalk and bottled water.

Be sure to bring sunscreen, a hat, and a cushion or knee pads for kneeling.

You may wish to bring the following additional supplies:

- Extra pastels, especially black and white
- Water spray bottles
- Dry paint brushes for blending colors
- Rags, hand vacuum or small broom and pan to keep you and your area dust free
